The 13th element of the periodic table is aluminium which is very light and corrosion-resistant metal. The aluminium is extruded into shutter blades and frames to suit design requirements and to optimise economy and strength. The aluminium sections are incredibly strong for their weight, accurate with a crisp appearance, straight and unaffected by moisture and impervious to insect attack. Overall they make the ideal external shutter that is equally suited to modern interiors.
